ONE OPTION: Kaye is offering a book study/Bible study starting in October. This study is based on the book "Uninvited" by Lysa TerKeurst and runs for 6 weeks at least. Meetings will be on Thursdays from 6:00-7:30pm starting possibly the first week in October. Location to be determined. The book and study guide will need to be purchased before the meeting and can be ordered online through CBD (Christian Book Distributors) for \$23 plus shipping and handling. Some questions this study deals with are: 1) Have you ever felt less than, left out, or lonely? 2) Are you struggling with past or current rejections, or feel consumed with seeking the approval of others? 3) Do you want to learn to live loved – truly loved by God? The format includes group time to watch the video and answer questions from the study guide, then prayer. During the week there is individual study (5 days) for reading and reflecting on the scripture/questions/exercises in the study guide. There is a suggested (not mandatory) correlated reading from the book (usually around 3 chapters). "I love... little baby ducks, old pickup trucks, slow moving trains... and rain.

I love... honest open smiles, kisses from a child, tomatoes on the vine... and onions.

I love... winners when they cry, losers when they try, music when it's good... and life."

These lines from a favorite childhood melody came to mind while thinking about thankfulness. ("I Love" performed by country singer Tom T Hall). They remind me to focus on the little things that we often take for granted. Those little items that may seem insignificant now can be life-changing or powerful for others, or even ourselves at times in our lives.

Oftentimes when we think about the things we love, such as family, friends, freedom, good food, church family, hikes in the woods, etc. we may have a sense of what our Heavenly Father feels when He studies his creation. Even though we humans may get frustrated or irritated at those we love, we still come back to the times when we are thankful for their presence. At difficult times, such as a loss or illness or time of great pain, we may become even more overwhelmed with thankfulness for the kindness of others and the presence of our Savior. Or, we may go through the opposite extreme and wonder why we should feel thankful when we are having such a tough time. Reading the words of Job or King David can help you put some of those questions into perspective. Another thought may help also... Have you ever imagined how much love our Lord and Savior has for us, and how much He feels our pain and sorrow? Our God has a bigger plan for us than we may understand.

Thankfulness is not only an emotion, but...it is an attitude of gratitude as well as a state of spirituality. It is SO MUCH MORE than a holiday, or a season, or even a time of reflection. Thankfulness is a constant state of being, in which we reflect on how blessed we are, and we tell others that they are an important part of our lives. Our first praises should always be for our gracious and merciful Lord and Savior, for without HIM we are nothing. (Sometimes this can be a struggle in our day to day busy lives, and we strive to try to create a purposeful time of thankfulness. Don't give up! Even a silent moment during your day to say "Thank You, God for this job" or "Thank you that my car started" is reflective of a thankful heart to God.) In addition, sharing a kind word to an old friend, inviting a new friend to dinner, telling your cashier to have a good day, or praying for your server, are also terrific ways to have a state of thankfulness in your heart.

I have learned that this state of being thankful can keep us calm in a stressful situation, can reduce a burden that seems overwhelming, and even take the edge off a painful experience, as long as we keep our measures of thankfulness full by appreciating the simple things we are blessed to have each day. Make your list of "I love's" ..., and sing along with Tom T Hall if you wish (U tube or Google it). But most importantly, reflect upon your own attitude of thankfulness which will fill your cup of love to overflowing. And remember our GOD is always telling us "And I... LOVE... YOU... TOO!
