The Unseen Expenses of SNA

My name is Laurel Horsley and I serve as treasurer for Saturday Night Alive. I was asked to write an article about the finances of Saturday Night Alive.

Every event we do is part of the ministry of Saturday Night Alive. Every event, from normal events like potlucks and Bible studies to the special events like the Christmas Banquet, have expenses that may not be noticeable to everyone.

When we host a special event that is catered, we of course have the expense of the food. (Sometimes we have the event catered by an outside source and sometimes we do our own catering.) But we also have other expenses that not everyone would recognize. If we have a speaker from outside of our group, we usually pay for that person's meal and their spouse's meal, if they bring him/her. Sometimes we pay them some sort of fee or offering. Those two expenses need to be included in the individual ticket price of the event. We also may have the cost of decorations, door prizes, name tags and paper products (like cups). When we host these special events, the event should pay for itself, without the extra expenses coming out of our savings.

The same rule applies to the Coffee Houses we have. We have a rental fee for the facility we use. We usually take up a free will offering for the entertainment and pay them that.

When we have potlucks (with or without a Bible study), we have the expense of all the paper products (plates, silverware, napkins, cups, etc), coffee and/or hot chocolate. We also like to have nametags for almost all of our events. Paper products are used for most events that are hosted even if we don't have a potluck. And we do pay Christian Life Ministries a small fee for the use of their facility.

There are a few other things we purchase each year. We have the newsletter that is put out 4 or 5 times a year. We have the cost of the paper to print it, but also mailing expenses like stamps and staples. To protect the privacy of people who are part of this ministry, we have a post office box. Many years ago, the return address on our mailings was the address of someone from the leadership team. We realized that was not a wise course of action which is why we now rent a post office box. We also pay a fee for our website because it was created and is maintained by an outside source. Some items are purchased by credit card, but other items require a check and the bank charges a fee for those.

It is because of all these unseen expenses that we take an offering (or try to do so) at almost all of our events. We also want each person who attends to feel like they are a part of the ministry of SNA and giving everyone the opportunity to contribute helps people feel included. The events planned by the leadership team are for all of you. Without you, SNA would not exist.
