As I sit here on January 4^{th} , 2020 with Blossom at my feet, recovering from a hernia operation with a colon resection, I am filled with many thoughts and emotions. My default response is to turn on the Hallmark channel and veg out, but that isn't working-actually it probably doesn't ever really work. First off I think Blossom can use the quiet, and I probably can as well. I have so much to process. I have learned so many lessons from this little dog, and this experience is no different. That is why I want to put it all down on paper. Maybe others will be blessed as well.

I adopted Blossom on May 11, 2019 from the Dakota Dachshund Rescue in Sioux Falls, SD. The idea of getting a doxie was kind of a whim. When I worked at the Animal Clinic as a vet tech, we acquired a sick little doxie after the owners could no longer afford treatment. He became the office dog and I fell in love. We named him Mr. Willy Wonka Wienie-Willy, for short. So, 20 plus years later I suddenly thought it would be fun to have a dog like him. Long story short, I feel like the Lord gave me the desire of my heart in finding Blossom. I intended to call my new dog Willy, but as I visited with Judy at the rescue, I said "It will be fun to watch her blossom." Then I thought-"that's her name - Blossom." These lessons are dedicated to the memory of Willy, who, just like Blossom, stole my heart.

I do feel like the Lord gave me the desire of my heart in Blossom and that she is His gift to me. At times I sense that my priorities can get mixed up and I can become almost obsessed with her. This life threatening hernia/surgery has reminded me that I am not in control. He is. She is His gift to me and she is in His hands.

It is now August 28, 2020 and I just read over what I wrote above. You would never know Blossom had surgery, unless you look at the very long scar on her tummy. She is truly living up to her name. Her little personality is coming out and she is much more confident. I am her human, that's for sure! What a joy she is and I am very thankful for her. I hope I can adequately share all the lessons the Lord has taught me through her. With His help, I can.

No Reason For It

Getting stressed out is such a waste of time!!! I mean really. If we think about it, how much of our lives have we wasted being stressed out over things that really didn't matter? This is another lesson I am learning from watching Blossom. I see her stress and get nervous and anxious for no reason. I think to myself "just relax and enjoy." Then I realize I do the exact same thing in my life. I get anxious and nervous and instead, could "just relax and enjoy." Being stressed, nervous and anxious over things isn't necessary. God is with me always. As my heavenly Father, He has only His best in store for me. His gives only good gifts to His children. I just need to remember that and walk in that fact.

I am seeing my reflection in how Blossom acts. She too, is learning that life doesn't have to be so scary. Even though I can't be with her always like God is with me, I am for her and want the best for her, just like He does with me. We both need to grow in this thing called trust.

Thank you, Lord for using a little dog-which you know I love-to teach me about trusting You and walking in your peace. Help me Lord to be a good example of You, not only to this dog, but also to everyone with whom I come in contact today and every day. Renew my mind with Your truth Lord, and help me to walk in it.
